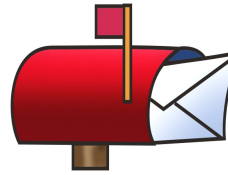

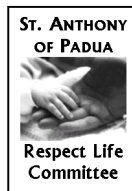

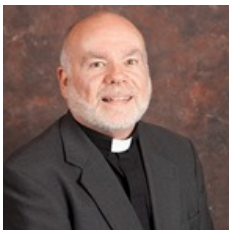
## Save the Date!
