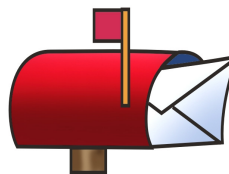

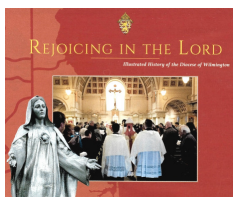

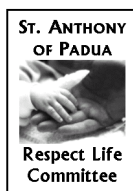
Second Collection

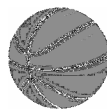
