



"After Paul and Barnabas had proclaimed the good news in that city they returned... to Antioch. They strengthened the spirits of the disciples and exhorted them to persevere in the faith, saying, 'It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the kingdom of God.' They appointed elders for them in each church, and with prayer and fasting, commended them to the Lord in whom they had put their faith."

The sad thing is not what has led others away, but that we have not been the Paul and Barnabas for them. Who needs to be strengthened in my circle of friends? Who is waiting to be invited to come or return to our flock?

- <u>Festival Money Cards</u>: For those who do not have a credit card, Festival Money Cards will be available to purchase on-site with cash. A Money Card may also be purchased with a credit card. The Money Cards replace cash, and will work like a Festival gift card or a credit card.
- IMPORTANT NOTE: Festival Gift Cards will NOT be accepted at the Midway. Midway patrons who have not purchased a Magic Money card prior to the start of the Italian Festival will need to visit the Majestic Midways kiosks on the Midway to purchase a Magic Money Card for use at Midway rides and games.


