

Today the Church breaks the cycle of Ordinary Time to celebrate the two great apostles, Peter and Paul. Each of them was sent by Jesus to establish his Church on sure foundations — Peter to the Jewish community and Paul to the Gentiles.

Today's gospel recounts Peter's profession of faith in Jesus as "the Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus uses that opportunity to call Peter "the rock" upon which he will build his Church. Jesus gives him authority to teach and to make decisions for his new community. Jesus knew Peter well. Peter could manifest great faith and love; he could also be impulsive and even deny him. But Jesus knew Peter's humility and courage that would be needed for the nurturing of this community's growth.

Jesus revealed himself to Paul later in life on the road to Emmaus. The conversion of Paul from a zealous Pharisee to an ardent disciple of Jesus is a special work of grace. Paul eventually understood that he was to preach the good news to the Gentile world with all the strength the Lord gave him.

St. Paul's example urges us on each day: "I have competed well; I have finished the race; I have kept the faith." May the Lord to bring us "safe to his heavenly kingdom."

Independence Day



Additional Liturgical Ministers Needed



We continue the series with the third Pastor of St. Anthony's, Father Roberto.


Rev. Roberto Balducelli, OSFS 1959 - 1988



Originally recruited in Italy by Father Tucker to come to St. Anthony's, which he did in 1946. Father Roberto was our "living link" to the Father Tucker era at St. He served as Pastor for 29 years. Anthony's. Intimately involved with the construction and establishment of many parish facilities, including the Grade School, Padua Academy, the Antonian, the Community Center, the Rectory, and St. Anthony-inthe-Hills. Father is also responsible for much of the artwork in the Church, Grade School, and in the hallways of Padua Academy. Often described as a true Renaissance Man, Father was equally at home celebrating Mass at an Altar, delivering a lecture to an attentive audience at a school or other community venue, or working with his hands - be it touching up a work of art with a fine brush, or using heavier tools in the fields and on the buildings out at St. Anthony-inthe-Hills. When his pastorship ended, he continued to perform priestly duties well into his nineties such as Baptizing babies and presiding over weddings and funerals. Father died August 9, 2013.


