I write to you this weekend for your prayers and for an important personal intention.

As many of you know, over the holidays I was hospitalized for an appendectomy. Subsequent to the surgery an infection required me to return to the hospital. During the treatment for the infection and unrelated to anything concerning it or the appendectomy, my medical team discovered growths on my pancreas and liver. After a biopsy on Monday, I was diagnosed with stage IV pancreatic cancer. This week I will begin a program of chemotherapy in the hopes of slowing the growth and spread of this disease.

Father James Greenfield, Oblate Provincial, has asked my brother Oblates to pray through the intercession of Blessed Louis Brisson, our Founder, for a miracle. I invite you to join in this prayer.
