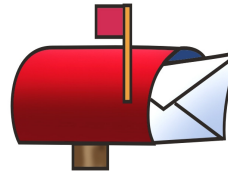

Next weekend, May 4th and 5th, there is no scheduled second collection.

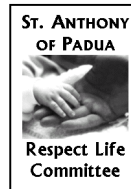
## BVM Sodality Spring Bake Sale This Weekend!
