

In today's Gospel we experience Jesus telling us to remain in His love. By remaining in His love we will learn to love one another. St. Francis de Sales notes:

Alas, we are like the eagles that have greater power of sight than flight. While we see how worthy of love God's goodness is, we have less strength of will for loving it.
