## St. Anthony of Padua Grade School Parish Council Report September 28, 2010

- Enrollment is currently 260 students in grades Pre-K3 through 8.
- Part time Librarian hired; Janice Vresics; a highly qualified Delaware teacher whose goal is "to provide a positive and stimulating learning environment where students successfully learn."
- Full time Science teacher, 8<sup>th</sup> grade homeroom teacher; Jessica Lowry; has taught Biology, Chemistry, Forensic Science, Algebra and Pre-Calculus. Mrs. Lowry has a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership from Neumann College and a B.S. in Liberal Studies from Widener University.
- Opening Liturgy was held at 9:30AM on Friday, August 27<sup>th</sup> for the school; on 11AM on Sunday, September 19<sup>th</sup>, for the parish which was also Catechetical Sunday.
- Back to school night on September 1<sup>st</sup> was well attended.
- Began program called Meet Your Student for Lunch. 2 classes each month will have parents come to highlight the lunch program. September 23<sup>rd</sup> hosted 3<sup>rd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade parents; in October we will host PreSchool and Grade 4 parents.
- Additional Open House to be held during the school day on November 18<sup>th</sup> during American Education Week.
- Improvements to the school include:
  - New state-of-the-art Computer Lab with 36 computers, new tables, monitors, mice and speakers. There is now a SMARTboard in the lab. Sr. Jamesanne teaches on Monday and Tuesday and the lab is available for student use on Wednesday through Friday.
  - o Painting was done in the Kindergarten and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade classroom as well as the hallways on the lower level and level one.
  - The previous computer classroom was carpeted and serves as the Faculty Room used for lunch and a work space.
  - Murals in Ballad Room and Kindergarten (painted by Fr. Roberto) are being restored and preserved.
  - o New curtains in the Ballad Room will be funded by the Home and School
  - o New stage curtains have been ordered to replace the original ones.
